PARKING:

PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION BEING PASSED ON BY FIRST:

It has come to our attention that Motorola has released an update for some of its Android phones that upgrade the phone to Android Nougat, version 7.x. This newer version of Android has not been thoroughly tested with the FTC Robot Controller and Driver Station apps. There are reported conflicts with running the FTC software (specifically the Driver Station) with Android Nougat. FIRST recommends that at this time you **do NOT upgrade any of your Android phones that you use for competition or practice to Android Nougat**. We will inform the community when support for Android Nougat is available.

WiFi Access:

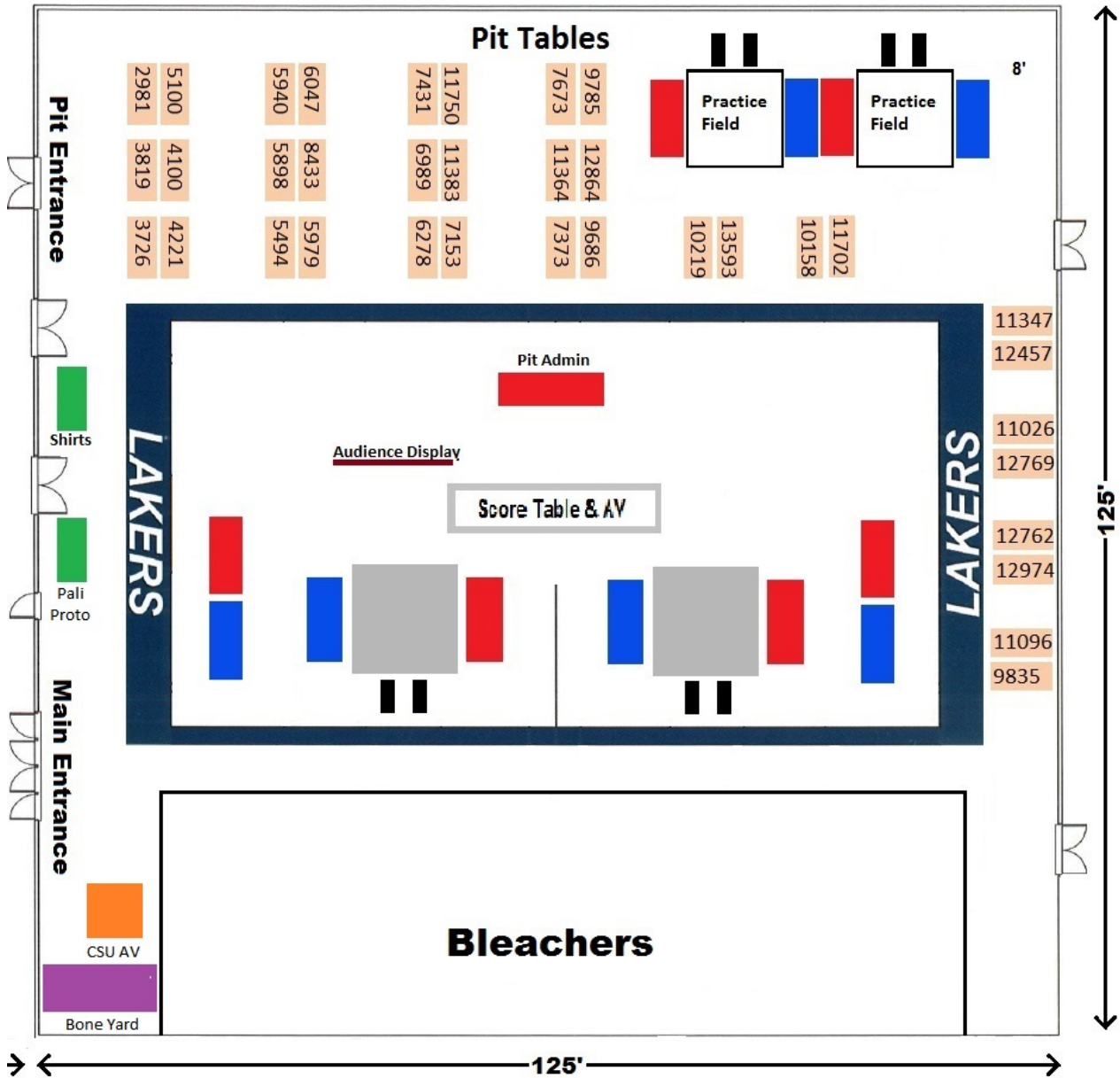
Guest WiFi is also being made available by Clayton State University for our event. Please remember to not utilize your own personal hotspot on your phone as this can interfere with robot performance.
